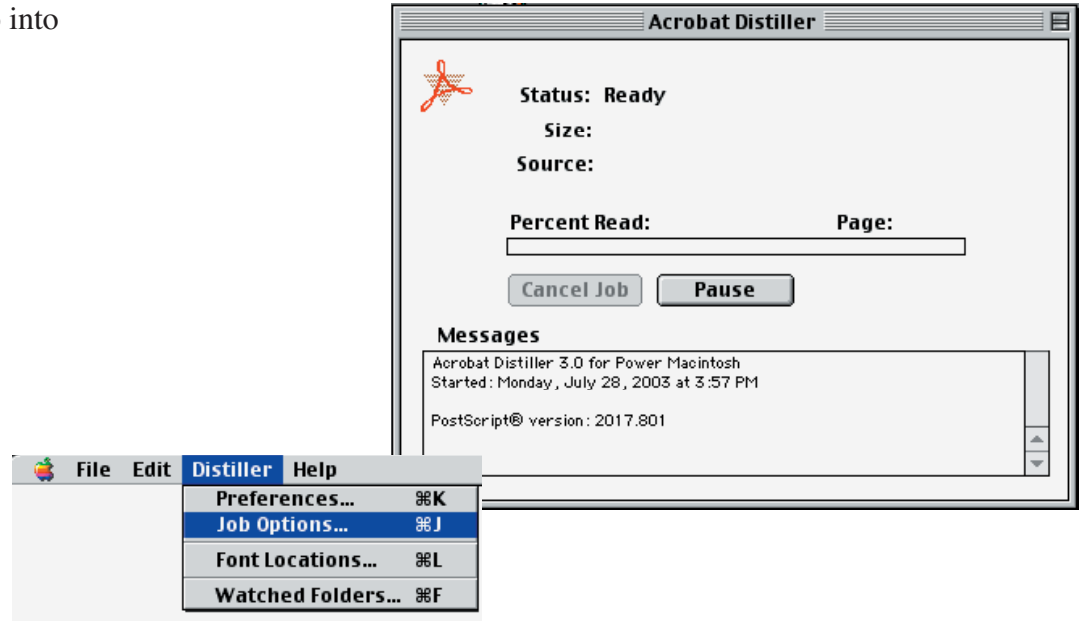


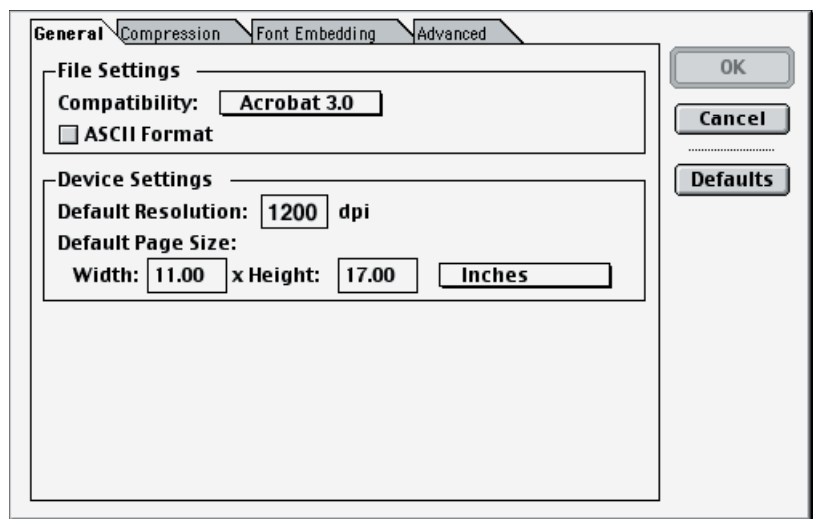
Distilling PostScript Files:  
**Adobe Acrobat Distiller 3.0 - Mac**

- With Distiller launched, go into  
**Distiller > Job Options...**

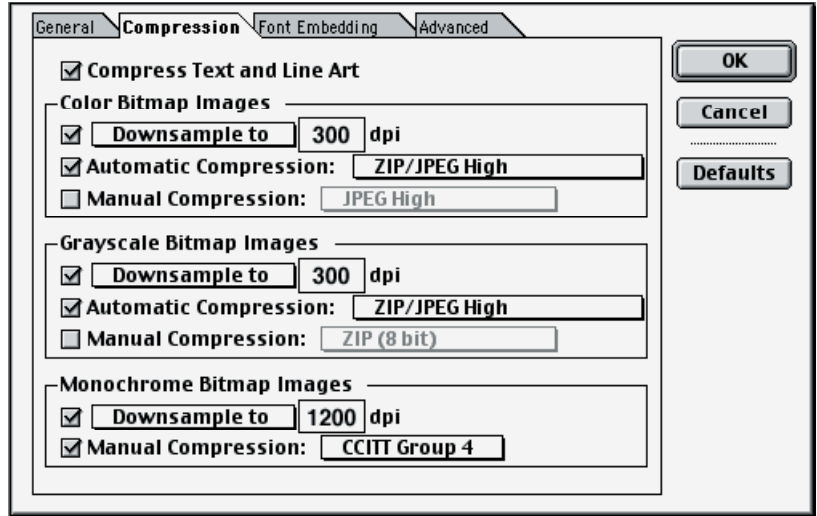


- Under the **General** Tab,  
match example to the right.

*Note: The Default Page Size depends on the size of your document and how much bleed you have assigned. Make sure that nothing is cut off in the PDF file.*

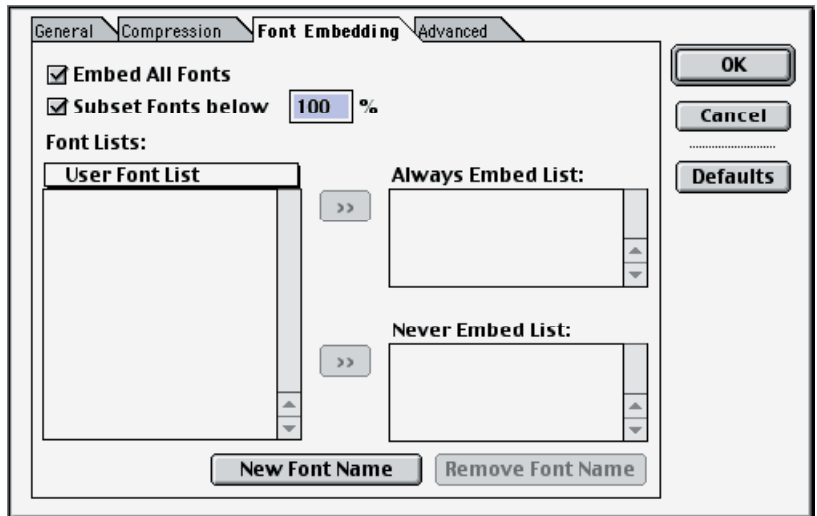


- Under the **Compression** Tab, match example to the right.



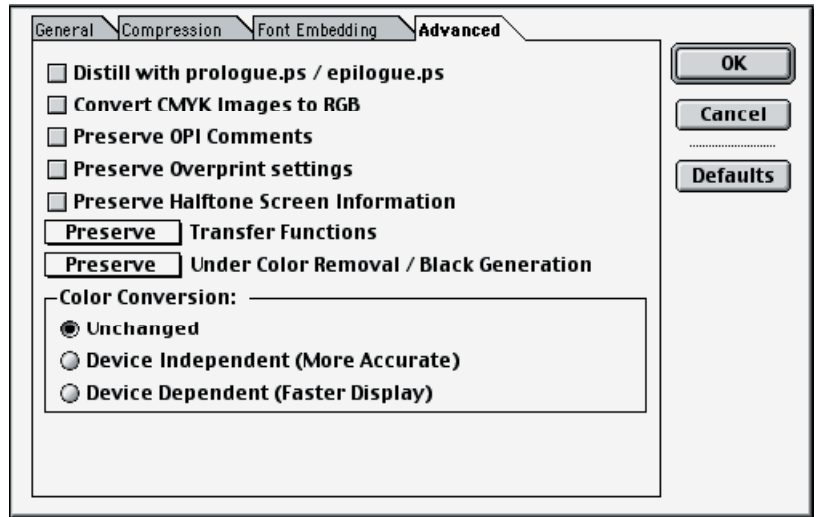
- Under the **Font Embedding** Tab, match example to the right.

*Note: Fonts must be embedded.*

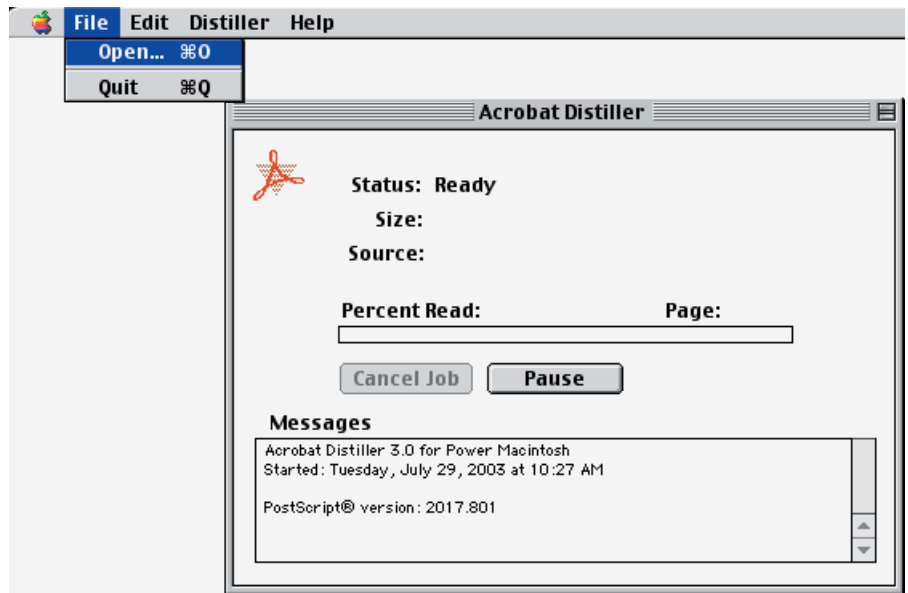


- Under the **Advanced** Tab, match example to the right.

*Note: The Color Conversion must be set to Unchanged. If your settings do not match these settings, a color profile may be assigned and this can result in color separation other than what you expected.*

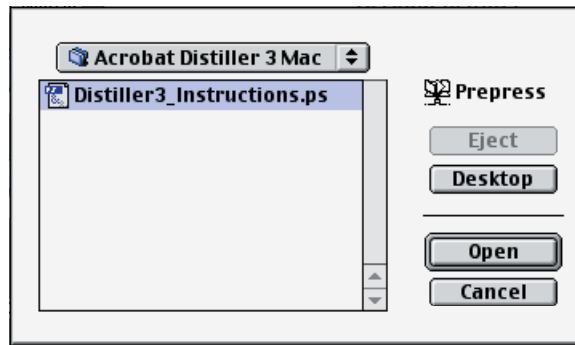


- To distill your PostScript file, go into **File > Open...**



- Navigate your way to the .ps file that you wish to distill.

- Click **Open**.



- Click **Save**.
